Detailed Itinerary

Day 1

The trip meets in Edinburgh at your accommodation anytime after 16:00, after which you will be able to check into your rooms. A Bus2alps trip leader will be in the lobby from 16:00-22:00. If your flight arrives early Friday morning or late Friday night, please inform your trip leader ahead of time. They will coordinate with the front desk to give you your room key and weekend information.

Day2

We will meet in the lobby for our walking tour, which will cover all the main sights of the Old City of Edinburgh. Starting on the famous Royal Mile, we will wander down the windy streets and up the hills to sites of executions, cloned sheep and the birthplace of Harry Potter. You then have the opportunity to explore the cobblestone streets of Edinburgh.

Afterwards you are free to participate in a variety of activities. For you Scottish Whiskey lovers, be a part of the Scotch Whiskey Experience Tour. Become a part of the whiskey making process while take a swirling, bubbling barrel ride through a replica distillery. Along the way, you'll hear the stories behind this magical craft, with expert tour guides and whiskey advisors with you every sip of the way. For the non-whiskey lovers, you can choose to embark to the top of the Edinburgh Castle. Here you can learn about the famous fortress which dominates the Edinburgh's skyline and houses the Scottish crown jewels.

We will then meet Monday night for New Europe pub crawl which will familiarize us with the beauty of the local Scottish pubs.

Day3

We make our way to Holyrood Park and pass the Holyrood Palace along the way. We then hike up to Arthur's seat for the most beautiful view of all of Edinburgh.
